- Jose Rojas has won the Cycle Instead Young Rider classification at the 2008 and 2009 Santos Tour Down Under events.
- Jose Rojas, Jose Ivan Gutierrez and Jose Garcia all competed at the 2010 Santos Tour Down Under.
- Jose Rojas finished third overall at the 2009 Santos Tour Down Under. He finished 23rd overall at the 2010 Santos Tour Down Under and third in the Cycle Instead Young Rider classification.

- Jose Ivan Gutierrez is the current Spanish National Road Race Champion – this is the second time he has taken national road race honours, winning the championship previously in 2001. He is also a three time Spanish National Time Trial Champion.
- David Lopez won Stage 9 of the 2010 Vuelta a Espana.
- Angel Madrazo won Stage 5 of the 2008 Circuit Montanes.
- Luis Pasamontes won the Mountains Classification at the 2007 Volta a Catalunya.
- Jose Garcia is a 2000 Tour de France stage winner and a two time Vuelta a Espana stage winner (1997, 2002).
- Francisco Ventoso joins the Movistar team in 2011.

## THE TEAM: DID YOU KNOW?

- Team Movistar revealed its new look for the 2011 season in December 2010 rolling out a simple, uncluttered blue and green design with the 'M' logo of its title sponsor.
