

# 2012 Bupa mini tour for kids presented by UniSA

## HEAT/EXTREME WEATHER POLICY

The Bupa mini tour for kids, presented by UniSA, (Sunday 22 January 2012) is one of the two recreational rides that make up the 2012 ŠKODA Breakaway Series, the official recreational ride program of the Santos Tour Down Under.

The decision to amend or cancel the Bupa mini tour for kids will be made by the event organisers Events South Australia (a division of the South Australian Tourism Commission) following advice from a dedicated working party.

Preventative measures identified by the event organisers will be in place prior to event day to minimise the effect of hot/extreme weather for riders in the Bupa mini tour for kids.

### RIDER RESPONSIBILITY

It is the responsibility of the participant/parent/guardian to ensure that participants use sunscreen, drink plenty of water & carry plenty of water with them, wear appropriate clothing and take advantage of shade and rest areas provided for the event they are participating in.

It is the responsibility of the participant/parent/guardian to make appropriate decisions about whether to start or continue riding based on their physical condition.

### CANCELLATION/AMENDMENT POLICY

#### Automatic Cancellation

If the Bureau of Meteorology forecast the temperature to be 40 degrees Celsius or above and those temperatures are expected to be reached at any point during the ride, then management will cancel the event.

#### Possible Cancellation

If the Bureau of Meteorology forecast the temperature to be between 36 and 39 degrees Celsius (inclusive), and those temperatures are expected to be reached through the duration of the event, management will consider other extreme weather factors and determine if the event is to be modified or cancelled.

## NOTIFICATION

Notification of event cancellation or modification may be made at:

6:00pm on Saturday 21 January 2012  
and / or

7:30am on Sunday 22 January 2012

Upon cancellation or modification the Event organisers will

- Send an SMS message and email to all participants and stakeholders (via phone and email).
- Notification will be provided to all on-site participants via PA system and/or signage
- Issue an official press release announcing the cancellation or modification of the event
- Communicate with media broadcast representatives, DMG (radio), The Advertiser (print) and Channel 9 (television) to issue on air 'media updates' advising of the cancellation or modification where possible.
