*** ESCAPE ROUTE**

Bupa Stage 4 of the Santos Tour Down Under is designed to test the professionals, as well as be a challenge for recreational riders. While most Bupa Challenge Tour riders will be capable of tackling the full distance they choose, all riders have the option to take the Escape Route, which will take out the ŠKODA King of the Mountain at Menglers Hill.

There is one Escape Route option:

When the ride route turns right to go up Menglers Hill, those taking the escape route will need to continue along Light Pass road, before taking a left turn into Vine Vale Road. Vine Vale road turns into Barossa Valley Highway and riders will need to follow this through into Murray Street for the finish near Basedow Road.

Riders are encouraged to opt for the Escape Route if they are at all unsure about completing the ŠKODA King of the Mountain. Riders must be cautious and ride within their abilities, taking into consideration the weather and other factors. The Escape Route will be signposted and Bupa Challenge Tour officials and event vehicles will regularly check this route.
