TASKS

- To assist the Rider Coach during the coaching process.
- To ensure participants ride in the correct direction (anti clockwise).
- To ensure participants only access the banking on the rider coach has instructed them to.
- To attend a training session with the Rider Coach in the lead up to the event
- To provide encouragement to the participants during the coaching and race experience.
- To assist the Rider Coach in ensuring participants follow the Rider Coach's instructions to follow the training lines.
- To be positioned within the apex of the banking to offer physical support including catching riders and preventing falls

SHIFT DATES & SHIFT TIMES

Monday 14th – Saturday 19th January – 3pm – 10pm daily

Sunday 20th January – 11am – 4pm

There will be a mandatory training session for all Street Velodrome volunteers on either Sunday 13 or Monday 14 January (Date and Time TBC).
